

# LOVETT DECONSTRUCTION'S DROPBOX DERBY IS BACK AT THE EASTBANK WATERFRONT, LABOR DAY 2019!

Lovett Deconstructions' Dropbox Derby is back! Three years in the running, the Dropbox Derby has drawn an exciting crowd of artists, designers, families, local business owners, DIY junkies, builders, contractors, tourists, and passers-by to witness Portland's biggest design-build challenge.

Last year, 27 teams raced the clock constructing projects out of identical batches of salvaged material according to a single theme. (Imagine an Iron Chef for artists and builders.) Teams had 4 hours to finish projects before 3 distinguished judges evaluated the projects for top awards. Meanwhile, completed projects were bid upon in a silent auction by attendees, with proceeds going to benefit a local nonprofit.

In 2018 an estimated 1,000 guests attended this spectacle of creativity and craft, enjoyed terrific food, drank local beer and cider, listened to a wide array of Portland-based music and marked the end of summer in style.

As home to perhaps the most vibrant maker community in the United States, Portland is, without a doubt, the most sustainable city in the United States and the Dropbox Derby aims to celebrate and solidify that.
